The DPF is mandated to protect the deposits in financial institutions that are regulated by the Bank of Uganda up to UGX 10 millions in the unlikely event of failure of such a bank/financial institution. DPF protects 98 percent of the total deposits in the financial sector regulated by Bank of Uganda.





A trend analysis of deposits over a five-year period


Growth in commercial bank deposits – June 2021
