## BEWARE OF FALSE CLAIMS OF PARTNERSHIP WITH THE DPF

It has come to the attention of the Deposit Protection Fund of Uganda that there are some online investment individuals and/or companies purporting that the deposits of their clients are protected by the DPF. Specific reference is made to GREEN MONDAY INVEST and ONPASSIVE. These unscrupulous individuals/companies are falsely claiming partnership with the DPF.

The public is hereby informed that the DPF does not have any such partnership with the above named institutions or any similar investment company/individual. The cases of GREEN MONDAY and ONPASSIVE have been brought to the attention of the relevant Government agencies for further management.





The public is therefore cautioned against dealing with the above-mentioned institutions or their agents, as doing so will be at your own risk. The public is further advised to report any such fraudulent companies/individuals to the nearest Police Station.

The DPF is an agency of the Government of Uganda which was established with the mandate to provide protection of up to a limit of ten million Uganda Shillings (UGX 10,000,000) to customers of deposit-taking institutions licensed and regulated by Bank of Uganda. There are currently thirty-three (33) Contributing Institutions comprising of twenty-five (25) Commercial Banks, four (4) Credit Institutions and four (4) Microfinance Deposit Taking Institutions.
